#### END TRACHOMA PROJECT - Kit Packing Night

Last week's meeting took a different format to the usual. The night started with a presentation to the Club from Gloria Hargraves, the Southern Region Rotarians Against Malaria (RAM) Co-ordinator. This certificate acknowledged the support our Club provided to RAM, by donating \$5,000. Gloria also paid credit to Murray Wilson for his role as D9810 RAM Co-ordinator. After a light dinner of finger food, the time came for packing the items that had been procured for the End Trachoma hygiene packs. After a few small hiccups along the way, we were proudly able to show the fruits of our labour – 30 family kits that will provide essential toiletry items to 120 members of the community at Nganmarriyanga. This community is quite isolated, about 375 km from Darwin. The next task will be to find a way of getting these kits to the school at Nganmarriyanga for distribution.




