Psychs on Bikes focuses on bringing the physical and mental health education and assessment to rural and remote communities around Australia by leveraging the appeal of a bunch of dirty and dusty mental heal professionals arriving on motorcycles. They do blood pressure checks and ask the question 'how are you going'.

Stephen enjoyed Tom Boyd's account of his mental health journey. Tom was the country's best young talent coming through the junior ranks, being selected with pick one of the 2013 AFL draft by GWS Giants who were in the infancy of their existence at the time. It was interesting to hear his struggles during his first season, with his struggles being attributed to home sickness. In July 2019 he walked away from a \$2million contract to achieve happiness in life. A very interesting story.
