Update on Regionalisation.

On April 11th the RI Board approved the Zone 8 Regionalisation Business Case. This means that the Regionalisation Pilot is now in the implementation phase.

The reality for Clubs is that it will have very little impact on the functioning on a Club. The structural changes will affect Districts to a much greater extent.

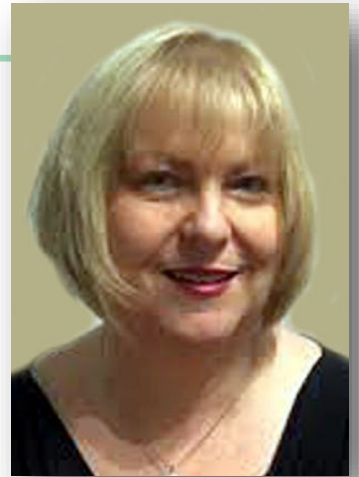
The objectives of the pilot project are:

- To support Clubs to increase membership
- To create new attractive leadership roles and development opportunities
- To build a stronger, unified Rotary brand
- To encourage partnerships, reduce duplication and improve efficiency.

Club Forum—session 2

The second session of the Club Forum provided the chance to use the Rotary Club Health Check to examine aspects such as Membership, Program, Club Experience and Administration, Social and Fundraising activities. The small group discussions were lively and reporting back to the larger group provided all present with an oversight of the responses. 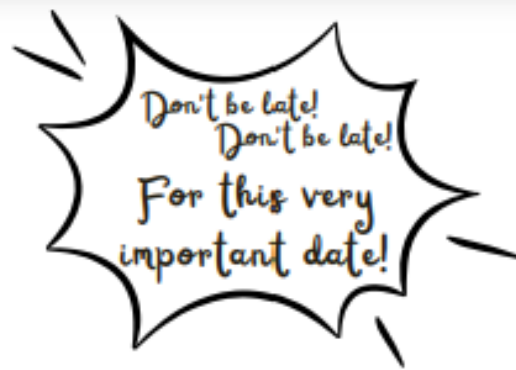
